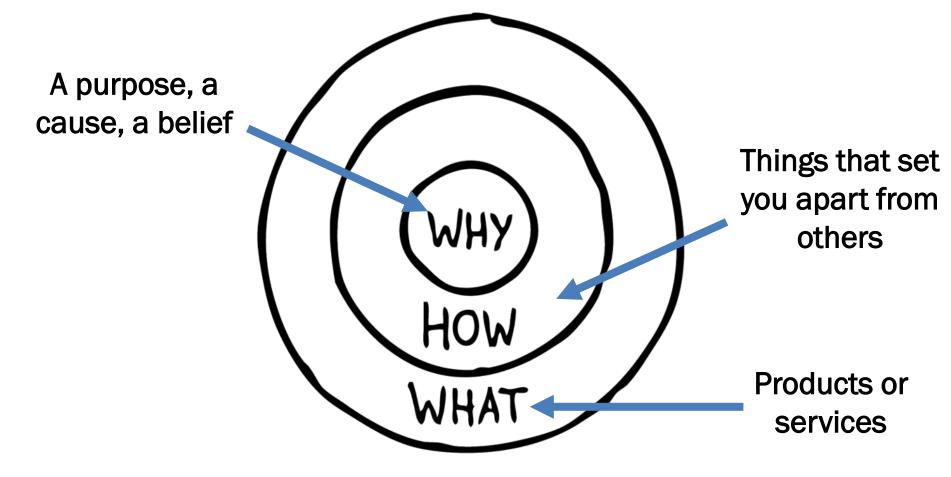

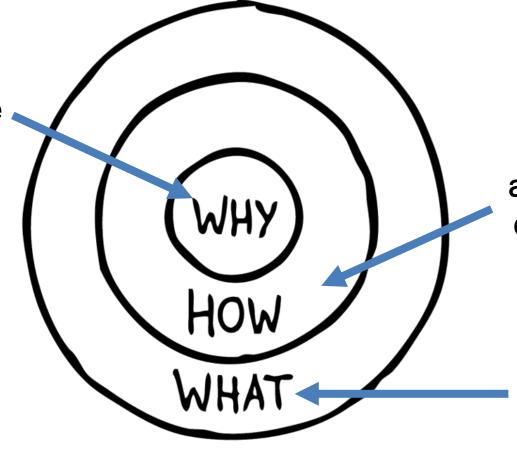

Her **WHY**: Because I believe in dignity, equality, and justice for Black Americans.

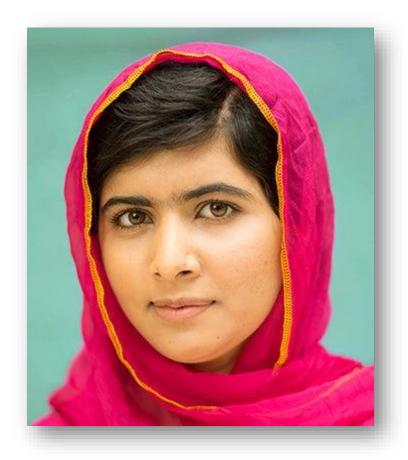






Her WHY: Because I believe that every girl deserves access to education.
